Try this one from Mary's recipe box...

Lemon-Lime Refrigerator Sheet Cake

1 pkg lemon deluxe cake mix

1 pkg lime gelatin

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

Dissolve gelatin in 3/4 c. boiling water. Add 1/2 c. cold water; set aside at room temperature.

Mix and bake cake as directed in a 13X9X2" pan. Cook cake 20-25 min.

Poke deep holes through top of warm cake (still in pan) with meat fork; spacing holes about one inch apart. With a cup, slowly pour gelatin mixture into holes. Refrigerate cake.
